Thursday Youth Group (year 10+) - We continued our series on how we live after finishing full-time education. We looked at the Church family. Are you being a good influence and standing up for your faith?

The Monday night interchurch football has been great for forming and progressing relationships. On Friday, Raise the Roof was excellent. Did you know that only about 10% of plastic gets recycled, and less than half of what is collected kerbside? Some of you will know that our daughter Ruth is currently working for Circular11, a British start-up company that recycles plastic to make plastic lumber – artificial “wood” used for benches, planters, etc. Mostly, they use mixed waste streams, but pure waste streams can allow them to tweak the mix, so if you would like to put your milk bottle tops in the box in the church lounge, it would enable us all to help, while enabling Ruth to still feel connected to the RBC family.
