Welcome to our Sunday Service

This Sunday, Ian Olliver and Rachel Hall will be leading our all-age service, looking at Exodus 3:1-17, 'Moses the Father'.

Kingdom Crew (Sundays during the service) In Kingdom Crew on Sunday, we looked at the miracle of when Jesus healed the man at the pool of Bethesda. We raced each other (unable to move in our normal ways), we had crafts which reminded us that God is always with us, whatever our circumstances, we explored the miracle together, we heard other real-life stories of God's healing... and when he sometimes shows us that healing someone isn't in His perfect plan for that person. We also spent time worshipping God together and chatting with Him through prayer.

Kingdom Club (Mondays during term time 3.30-4.45pm) In Kingdom Club on Monday, we thought about how the Holy Spirit teaches us truth. We played games where our friends had to work out whether we were telling the truth about ourselves or a lie - we found out lots of amazing things about each other! We thought about the truth that God never lies, and so we can always trust Him. The more we read our Bibles and spend time with Him, the better we'll get at recognising the truths that God is telling us.

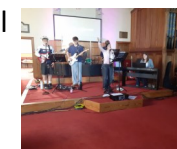
